The continued use of MOD Ranges and Bisley

The National Rifle Association has concluded an agreement with the Ministry Of Defence, which includes requirements for shooters to hold a Certificate of Competence for the types of firearm being used, prior to permitting use of ranges owned or managed by the MOD and this includes the Bisley Ranges.

The certificates of competence (which will be renewed annually) can be issued by any club affiliated to the National Rifle Association and this includes the MLAGB. These certificates must be signed by the Association Chairman.

The MLAGB intend that all our members who make use of MOD Ranges or Bisley will be able to continue to do so, therefor certificates will again be issued on application. The form required will be printed overleaf and can also be downloaded from the MLAGB Web Site.

There are a number of criteria, which need to be met before a member can be issued with an Annual Shooters Safety Certificate without further investigation of his ability. There will also be members who would need to look at the Special Circumstances criteria of the application which will require the endorsement of your Branch Secretary who can vouch for your safety and experience with the type of firearm or firearms you may wish to use on MOD Ranges.
