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## Short Range Championship 2018, WEDGNOCK

#### The Competitions

##### 100m Military Rifle Competitions

- 001 ENFIELD CUP class O, shots 10/13, Enfields only.  
002 PARKER-HALE TROPHY class R, shots 10/13 reproduction military Enfield type rifles only.  
003 BELL TROPHY class O, shots 10, Enfields only, neither use of spotting telescope allowed nor any coaching.  
004 BELL REPRO as 003 but class R.

##### 100m Free Rifle Competitions

- 021 SILVER SPOON class O, shots 10/13, Free Rifle.  
022 LOCKRIDGE-HUPPENBAUER as 021 but class R.  
023 WORSLEY CUP shots 10/13, class O, Flintlock Rifles.  
024 HUDSON CUP as 023 but class R.  
025 LADIES CUP shots 10/13, class O or R.  
026 SOUTHERN COUNTIES TROPHY as 003 but Free Rifle.  
027 SOUTHERN COUNTIES REPRO as 026 but class R.  
028 CAPTAIN FORSYTH TROPHY shots 10, any double barrel rifle, shots to be taken alternately from each barrel, any position except prone, or standing.  
029 PATCHED BALL CUP shots 5 prone, and 5 kneeling a total of 10, all to count. Class O. Any rifle or smoothbore patched spherical ball only, no mechanically fitting projectiles allowed.  
030 PATCHED BALL REPRO as 029 but class R.

##### 50m Offhand Rifle Competitions

- 041 BILL MOORE TROPHY shots 10/13, class O, Enfields only, Offhand 50 metres.  
042 HOLBROOK CUP as 041 but class R.  
043 WHITWORTH CUP as 041 but Free Rifle.  
044 HYTHE TROPHY as 043 but class R.  
045 REX CUP 10/13 shots flint rifle Class O  
046 The Fenton 10/13 as above but Class R

##### 50m Offhand Musket Competitions

- 061 WATERLOO TROPHY shots 10/13, class O, flintlock military muskets as defined, offhand.  
062 LOVELL TROPHY as 061 but class P percussion.  
063 WATERLOO REPRO as 061 but class R.  
064 COURTNEY CUP as 061 but any smoothbore matchlock.  
065 BROWN BESS CUP shots 10, class O, time limit ten minutes, Brown Bess Muskets only as defined.  
066 BROWN BESS REPRO as 065 but class R.  
067 JONATHAN CUP shots 10/13, any smoothbore matchlock kneeling.  
068 J.SALMON TROPHY shots 10, any double barrel rifle, shots to be taken alternately from each barrel, offhand.

##### Rifle Aggregates

- 103 E.J. BURTON EXPERTS TROPHY - CLASS O FREE RIFLE AGGREGATE  
Awarded to the highest aggregate from 001, 021 and 043.  
104 JERSEY CUP - CLASS R FREE RIFLE AGGREGATE  
Awarded to the highest aggregate from 002, 022 and 044.  
105 ENFIELD EXPERTS CUP - CLASS O ENFIELD AGGREGATE  
Awarded to the highest aggregate from 001, 003 and 041.  
106 WILLIAMS CUP - CLASS R ENFIELD AGGREGATE  
Awarded to the highest aggregate from 002, 004 and 042.

##### Rifle Team Events

- 121 BRANCH ENFIELD TEAMS  
Teams of three from any Branch at the Short Range Championships. Teams to be nominated in advance and at the same time choice of either competition 001 or 002 to be stated for each shooter. Branches with insufficient members present may amalgamate with each other to create a team of three.

##### Concurrent Rifle Matches

- 141 SWEENEY CUP - LADIES 100 METRE  
Awarded to the lady with the highest score in any 100 metre prone rifle match at the Short Range championships.

#### Conditions of the Meeting

1. All entries must be made on the Entry Form and sent, together with the correct entry fee, to the organiser.
2. All competitors must be fully paid up members of the MLAGB and residents of the United Kingdom or British Subjects. Members not being resident in, or Citizens of, the United Kingdom are welcome to enter but will not be eligible to compete for national trophies or medals. Visitors' medal will be available for this class of entrant who makes a score in the top three places of any competition.
3. Late entries may be accepted subject to range availability and will attract a surcharge of £1 per entry. Practice targets and re-entries are not allowed under any circumstances.
4. It is a condition of entry that competitors may be called upon to act as assistant Range Officers or scorers at certain times during the meeting.
5. The appointed Range Officer will signal the start and finish times of each detail. No capping off, flashing of pans or fouling shots will be permitted outside these details times.
6. Full details of matches, rules, and classes, will be found in the MLAGB Rule Book and are summarised above.
7. All trophies and cups awarded at previous Short Range Championships must be returned during this meeting or sent recorded delivery to MLAGB c/o Helen Harper Smith, PO Box 58, Etchingam TN19 7XH to arrive at least one week before the meeting. Please ensure trophies and cups are clean, engraved as appropriate, and in a suitable condition for presentation.
8. Shooters wishing to enter the Aggregates must complete and return the Aggregates Claims Form available on the day. Failure to do so may exclude your scores from the Aggregate.
9. Targets should be collected from the Stats Office on arrival. It is the shooter's responsibility to fix his or her target prior to the start of the chosen detail and to collect and return it to the Stats Office after the detail has finished.
10. All targets must bear the appropriate sticker(s). Any target presented for scoring without the appropriate sticker may be disqualified.
11. Once you have collected your targets you may shoot on either day on a lane and target detail of your choice. Details start at 10:00, 10:45, 11:30, 12:15, 13:00, 13:45, 14:30, 15:15 & 16:00. There will be a 15-minute cease-fire between details to allow changing of targets. No capping, flashing of firearms or fouling shots are permitted during this ceasefire.
12. Any competitor wishing to challenge a score must first put down a deposit of £5 which will be forfeit if the challenge is not upheld.
13. If you think you are likely to win a medal and cannot attend the Prize Giving, please nominate someone to collect it on your behalf. Medals to Third place will be issued in all competitions with five or more entries. Gold medals only will be awarded in competitions with less than five entries.
14. Coaching is not permissible under any circumstances.
15. The Range Officer's decision is final and binding in all disputes.
16. Eye protection must be worn at all times while shooting is taking place. This rule applies to all competitors and spectators who are situated in front of the metal barrier separating the shooting and spectator areas on A, B, or C ranges.
17. Hearing protection must be worn at all times while shooting is taking place. This rule applies to all competitors and spectators who are situated anywhere in the firing point buildings on A, B or C ranges while shooting is taking place.
