

## Match Director – 12<sup>th</sup> MLAIC Long Range World Championship: Bisley, 2019

Long range rifle target events are an important and growing part of muzzle loading shooting. Original and reproduction rifles are shot at distances of up to 1000 yards, recreating some of the early rifle competitions that came about during the volunteer movement in the mid to late Victorian period.

The Muzzle Loading Associations International Committee (MLAIC) is the world governing body of competitive muzzle loading shooting, and is the umbrella organisation responsible for world and regional competitions. MLAIC Long Range rifle world championships are held every other year.

In 2019, the MLAGB has been offered the opportunity to host the 12<sup>th</sup> MLAIC Long Range World Championship in Great Britain and is actively seeking a Match Director for this event. His/her main duties will include:

- Arranging dates for the event at Bisley, liaising closely with the NRA
- Organising visitors permits, working with the MLAGB police liaison officer
- Organising range staff and any markers that are needed
- Organising entry forms and other administrative tasks
- Arranging the opening ceremony and closing banquet

Please note that a great deal of help will be available to the successful candidate from MLAGB members and members of the MLAGB council of management.
