**Covid-19 Precautions – Currently (July 2020) the NRA have imposed restrictions on range use (these may be relaxed by September – but don't hold your breath):**

- Cheylesmore B is restricted to 10 firing points, with an empty point between shooters to maintain separation. To maximise usage, therefore, it is proposed that competitors booking a half day session (4 scorecards or more) will be given precedence for a session. Competitors wishing to shoot fewer cards will be scheduled after the full session (before lunch or early evening) unless there are vacant firing points.
- Shooters are not to engage, face-to-face, with each other
- The RO's will control movement between firing points and target frames to change targets - only handle your own target faces. Targets will be scored by the scorekeeper. Competitors will be issued with stickers for their targets – identifying the shooter and match.
- On arrival you must sign in and we will need to see your *bona fides*— Membership Card(s) and “Shooter Certification Card (SCC)” for M-L pistols – you can get one from your Club Chairman. No SSC – No shoot.

There is £2 off Registration if you are an *individual* member of MLAGB and/or SLRC and/or NRA. ) and also an EARLY ENTRY DISCOUNT (£2 off each Scorecard) **if you get the Entry Form to us by 12<sup>th</sup> September.**

REGISTRATION includes ONE Scorecard. *Please ensure that you have shown this overleaf.*

Additional Courses can be entered in advance if you know what to shoot -- fill in the form overleaf so we can prepare your Scorecards. OR you can turn up and see if there is range space on the day(s).

Registered Competitors take precedence and “Earlies” will pay the reduced Match Entry Fees “on the Day” as well.

We want to include the widest range of muzzle loading firearms in this competition. We welcome shooters using black powder or modern substitutes. We welcome shooters using modern designs, originals or reproductions. The competitions and awards are graded to distinguish and reward skilled shots regardless of their choice of firearm, but above all the competitions are aimed at being inclusive, challenging and fun.

**Smokeless Powder?** Except for an ORIGINAL 19thC revolver Black Powder is not obligatory but if you use a B.P. substitute it would be prudent to ensure that your revolver is properly proofed.

PLEASE NOTE that there will be at least 5 details per half day (we hope to “squeeze in” one more), some with Slow-, Timed-& Rapid-fire and some with Bobber and Surrenden. Add extras “on the day” as available.

Enter the **NUMBER of TIMES** that you want to shoot a particular course –

You might want to shoot the SAME COURSE several times using the SAME firearm with different STANCES, (e.g., two-handed AND offhand) ---or ---if you have a “Double-Action” revolver using BOTH “single-action” AND ”double action”.

You might want to shoot the SAME COURSE in the SAME WAY with DIFFERENT firearms, e.g., one-handed with a “Colt Navy” and a “Remington”

PERCUSSION TARGET REVOLVER can only be shot “offhand” (i.e., one-handed).

\*\*\* If you want to shoot one “SUPPORTED” then please enter “FREE REVOLVER”.

In some MATCHES the choice of HAMMER ACTION (a.k.a. “single action” –the hammer is raised to full cock and then fired with a separate action of the trigger) or TRIGGER ACTION (a.k.a. “double action” –one “pull” of the trigger raises and drops the hammer) is left to the firer but there are Special Awards for the highest scores for a particular type of firearm.

For “Modern Muzzle-Loader the “Patriot” is classed as HAMMER ACTION.

Ruger Old Army revolvers with **non-adjustable sights** can be shot in the Standard Percussion Revolver matches.

**AWARDS** are scaled according to entry. PLACES – 1-3 firers = 1<sup>st</sup>, 4-6 firers = 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7+ firers = 1, 2 & 3.

After the PLACE Awards we give Skilled Shot Certificates to 20% of the entry; First Class Shot Certs to 10%, Marksman to 5%. Obviously in some courses a 2-handed hold has a significant advantage, so for these we ALWAYS have separate Prize Lists, but where they have to be combined (i.e., one Prize List due to a small entry) we make Special Awards for the highest Offhand scores. The same principle applies for “Single-Action” in faster courses - and also Awards for “Open Frame” revolvers , “Originals” and others.
