Annual Shooters Safety Certification 2021

Dear Member

The continued use of MOD Ranges and Bisley

The National Rifle Association has been issuing Shooter Certification Cards (SCC) to affiliated clubs for the past ten years following agreement with the MoD that civilian shooters have to be certified to shoot on MoD ranges. The NRA requires shooters to hold an SCC to use Bisley ranges.

All issued affiliated club SCCs expired on 31st December 2018 and the NRA have taken the opportunity to review the process and have made the decision to produce all future club SCCs in house for affiliated clubs on an annual basis. The MLAGB will continue to train and certify its members as is the current practice. The new NRA SCC will carry a photograph of the member.

The MLAGB will be administering the scheme for its members, and will provide the necessary information to the NRA to allow them to issue SCCs for MLAGB members.

MLAGB members requiring SCCs should:

- Fill in and send the appropriate form - forms are printed in *Black Powder* and are also available for download on the MLAGB web site.
- Completed forms should be sent **together with a passport style photograph** to the MLAGB chairman at the address shown on the form. The passport photo should have the members name written on the back. Alternatively, scanned copies of the form and photograph may be emailed to membership@mlagb.com.
- The chairman will forward details of approved applications to the MLAGB membership office who will handle the administration, and liaise with the NRA.
- As SCCs are issued by the NRA and will be posted by them to the MLAGB membership office, the MLAGB will post SCC back to the member. An SAE is therefore no longer required with each application.
